**6 EXAMPLES OF CHILDREN WHO MET THE RESEARCH
CRITERIA**

1. Abbie became looked after before 31/03/01 and was discharged from care on 01/03/05.
2. Bill became looked after before 31/03/01 and was discharged from care between 01/04/02 and 31/03/03.
3. Chris became looked after before 31/03/01 and was discharged from care between 01/04/01 and 31/03/02.
4. Diane became looked after on the 01/04/03 and was discharged from care between 01/04/04 and 31/03/05.
5. Over the research period Elvis had 2 episodes of being looked after. Elvis became looked after on the 01/04/01 and was discharged from care between 01/04/02 and 31/03/03. Elvis was then re-admitted to care between 01/04/03 and 31/03/04 and discharged from care between 01/04/04 and 31/03/05.
6. Frank also had more than one episode of being looked after. Frank was admitted to care before 31/03/01 and then discharged between 01/04/01 and 31/03/02. Frank was then re-admitted to care between 01/04/02 and 31/03/03 and discharged from care between 01/04/03 and 31/03/04. Frank then became looked after 01/04/03 and 31/03/04 and was discharged between 01/04/04 and 31/03/05.
